### ABOUT TAG7

Tag7 is a rugby league based, non contact hybrid designed to genuinely develop rugby league skill. Built on real league structure including tag zero to tag six, kicking options, positional roles, tempo, decision making and defensive organisation, Tag7 rewards the same actions that win real games. The Tag7 Tournament Series provides pre season and post season competition designed to keep rugby league skills sharp and developing year round in a fast, safe and structured environment.

### TOURNAMENT OVERVIEW

The 2026 to 2027 Tag7 Tournament Series consists of two major tournaments held in late September and early March at Walker Park, Yass.

Teams may enter both tournaments as **Tag7 Foundation Teams**, or enter the March tournament only via the **Wildcard Entry System**.

---

### DIVISIONS

Boys and Girls divisions are offered in the following age groups:

- Under 11
  - Under 13
  - Under 15
  - Under 17
- 

### AGE ELIGIBILITY

Age eligibility is determined by year of birth and applies across the entire 2026 to 2027 season.

Players eligible for an age group in the late September tournament remain eligible for the same age group in the early March tournament, even if they have a birthday during the season.

Players may play up a maximum of **two age groups**, provided they meet the minimum age requirement at the time of the tournament.

#### Example:

A player may compete in the Under 11 division if they are **9 years of age or older** on the day of the tournament.

Year of birth is required for all players to confirm age eligibility.

---

### COMPETITION FORMAT

- Matches are played with **7 players on the field**
- Rolling substitutions apply
- Teams must have 14 players registered
- Each team is guaranteed a **minimum of 6 games per tournament**
- Pool matches progress to finals, with a **Grand Final in each division**
- Games are played as **one continuous 25 minute match** to maintain tempo, flow and involvement

Each division consists of a maximum of **8 teams**.

Teams will play **5 pool games**, including crossover matches.

All teams qualify for a **Quarter Final**, with **Cup and Plate Semi Finals** used where required to ensure each team plays a minimum of 6 games per tournament.

---

### REGISTRATION PROCESS

Team registration is completed in two simple stages.

### Team Registration (Team Manager)

The team manager completes the team registration and pays the **\$600 Foundation Team registration fee**.

This includes:

- Entry into the September tournament
- A reserved team place in the March tournament
- An official shirt sponsor as part of the Foundation Team package

Once registration is confirmed, the team manager will receive a unique registration link or code to share with players.

---

### Individual Player Registration

Players use the provided link or code to complete individual registration.

This covers participation in **both tournaments** and includes the official **Tag7 playing uniform**, consisting of:

- Playing shirt
  - Playing shorts
- 

### MARCH TOURNAMENT – FOUNDATION TEAMS ONLY

Foundation Teams returning for the March tournament only are required to pay a reduced **\$500 team registration fee**.

No additional individual registration is required for March unless:

- A new player is added to an existing team, and
  - A Tag7 uniform (shirt and shorts) is required
- 

### FOUNDATION TEAMS

Teams entering both tournaments are recognised as **Tag7 Foundation Teams** and receive priority benefits across the 2026 to 2027 season.

---

### WILDCARD ENTRY

Wildcard entry is available for new or late forming teams entering the **March tournament only**. Wildcard teams are **not classified as Foundation Teams**.
